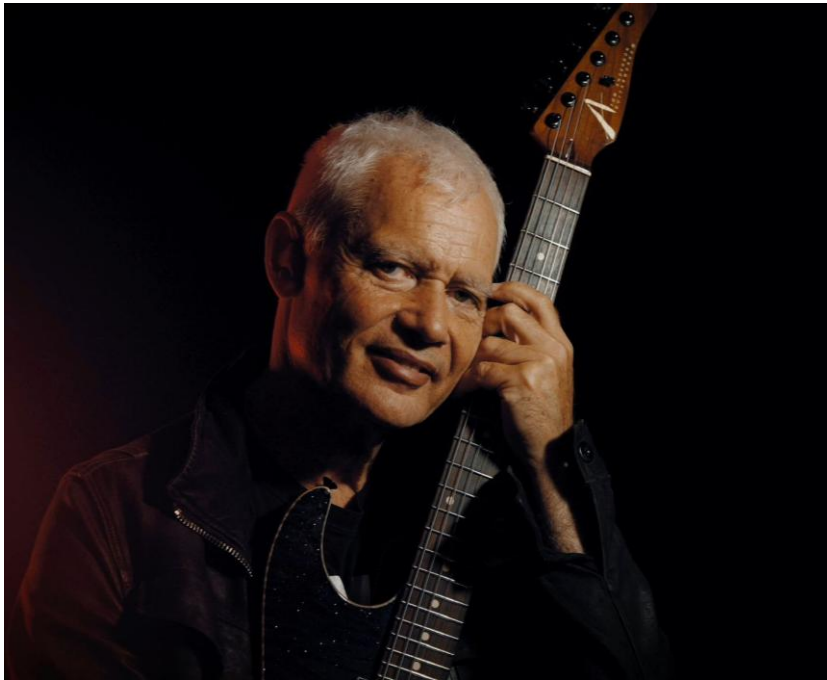


Their repertoire includes French chansons — Andrea's signature genre — but their real focus is on inventive arrangements of familiar, yet “unworn” hits, specially arranged for the guitar + vocal duo format.



Since musicality is the heart of their act, audiences get to hear each song differently every time. Improvisation in the moment is their greatest strength. In these original versions you'll hear songs by Stevie Wonder, Tina Turner, Tom Petty, Etta James, The Carpenters, Sting, Michael Jackson...

They also put a unique spin on well-known rock classics like Chicago, AC/DC and more.



Juraj Burian: Guitarist, Arranger, Producer

A graduate of the Bratislava Conservatory and Berklee College of Music in Boston, USA (1992–95), Juraj has collaborated with the biggest names on the Slovak and Czech music scene. He was twice named Instrumentalist of the Year (1990 and 2001). He represented Slovakia at the Eurovision Song Contest 1996 in Oslo with the song *Kým nás máš* — still Slovakia's highest placement in the competition to date.

At Berklee he connected with top international musicians he still works with today, bringing artists like Swedish drummer Johan Svensson and Norwegian bassist Per Mathisen regularly to Slovak stages. Juraj is currently preparing his solo album and teaches at the Bratislava Conservatory.



Andrea Zimányiová: singer

Andrea Zimányiová was born in Bratislava. She won the first edition of the nationwide French Song competition in 1999, and a year later took the international prize at the Split Festival. For ten years she's been the lead singer of the band Margot, which released the debut album *Bez obalu* in 2006 and *Mať tak krídla* in 2007. Her solo album *Okno do duše*, co-produced and co-written by Juraj Burian, came out in 2016. She's performed with the Gustáv Brom Orchestra on the TV show *Let's Dance* and reached the Slovak national final of Eurovision with her own song. Today she's a respected vocalist who collaborates with symphony orchestras, works as a TV judge, and appears in various TV shows.
